Truth Matters! A BIBLICAL HISTORY OF MIRACLES IN THE BIBLE Matt. 16:4 "A wicked and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign.."

Today almost every piece of mail I receive and almost every convention advertisement in Charisma magazine is crying out "signs & wonders." The vast majority of Charismatics believe that the Church is entering the time when miracles, signs, and wonders will become common place. They teach that miracles are the birth-right of the believer and they imply that in the early Church they were common.

However, just a quick glance through the Bible will prove that **miracles were not** common place at all. In fact, miracles were very rare and those that actually worked miracles are less than 20 people (unless you want to add in all of the 70, although we do not know if they performed any true "miracles" per se). The dates cited below come from the Ryie Study Bible and NavPress CD Rom.

> That's all folks! The rank-and-file Christian did not perform any miracles in the Bible. Entire Church groups were not known for their signs and wonders. How to perform miracles or obtain stronger anointings are not taught in Scripture nor throughout Church history (until quite recently that is).

Paul stated (2 Cor. 12:12) that he performed the signs of a true apostle among believers as a seal of his apostleship. It was this God-given ability that proved to the congregation that Paul was in fact an apostle.

Miracles were NOT common place in the O.T. nor in the N.T. They have NEVER been common place in the economy of God or the history of the Church.
