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Preface:

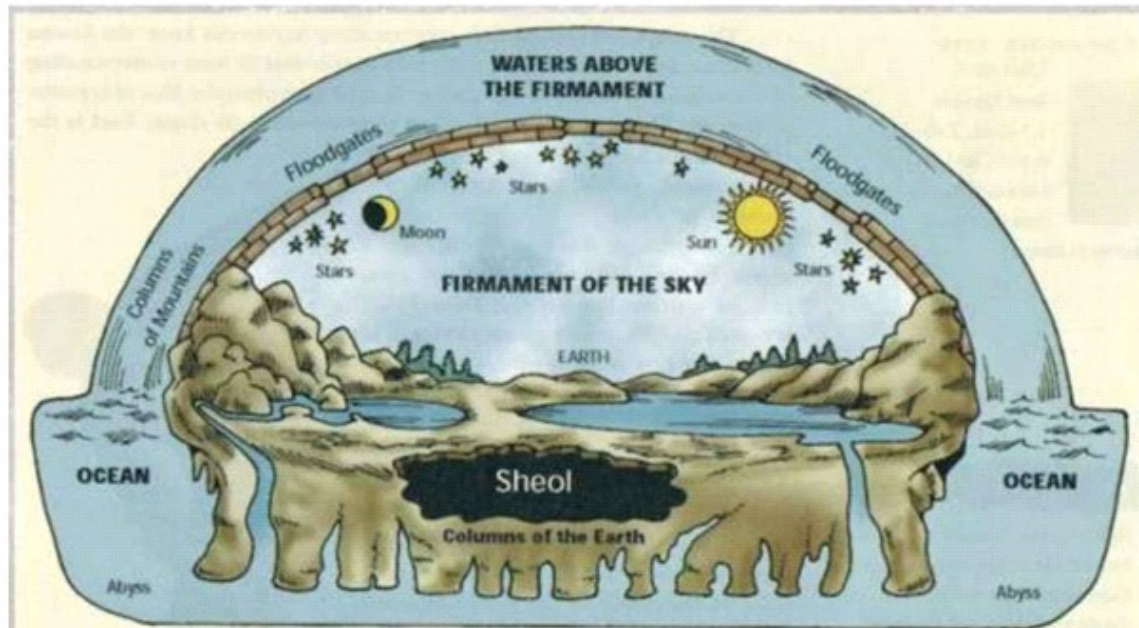
Does the Bible teaches a flat earth or a round one? That is the question I wish to answer in this expanded Booklet , Explaining why I made the choice to be a flat earther due to my belief in the scripture. It has been more than a year since I wrote my first edition and it had some typos and in which my knowlge was limited compare to what I know now of how the Bible describes a flat earth. And if the Bible teaches a flat earth are you willing to believe the Bible if it goes against what the world calls science. This was not a subject I ever thought I would write about it, because I thought the Bible suported the idea of a round earth. But a careful study of the scripture showed me I was wrong. The purpose of this booklet is to show what the Bible teaches on the matter and leave everyone with the option to believe the Bible or not on the matter. This is not a salvation issue but it is a important one for the Bible makes it very clear that the earth is not around globe but a flat earth. And if one can not trust what the Bible states on the shape of the earth how will you trust it in referance to the after life or in what it states on salvation. Yes I understand that when reading the Bible we have to know it has differant kinds of genre as literature some is poetic, some symbolic, some historical and some prophetic. This is all acknowlge by the author but the fact that everthing is pointing out to a flat earth is concerning and it cause me to rethink science in a number of details.

Chapter 01: The Dome of the Earth

The New Revised Standard Version states that the earth has a dome above which separates the waters above from those that are under it.

(Genesis 1:6-8) And God said, "Let there be a dome in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters from the waters." So God made the dome and separated the waters that were under the dome from the waters that were above the dome. And it was so. God called the dome Sky. And there was evening and there was morning, the second day. (NRSV)

Other translations like NKJV uses firmament, BBE uses a solid arch and the arch, Darby uses an expanse



The IVP Bible Background Commentary states about Genesis 1: 6 - 8 the following {"1:6-8. firmament. In a similar way the expanse (sometimes called "the firmament") set up in day two is the regulator of climate. The ancient Near Eastern cultures viewed the cosmos as featuring a three-tiered structure consisting of the heavens, the earth and the underworld. Climate originated from the heavens, and the expanse was seen as the mechanism that regulated moisture and sunlight. Though in the ancient world the expanse was generally viewed as more solid than we would understand it today, it is not the physical composition that is important but the function. In the Babylonian creation epic, Enuma Elish, the goddess representing this cosmic ocean, Tiamat, is divided in half by Marduk to make the waters above and the waters below."}

As we read in The IVP Bible Background Commentary even ancient writings spoke of this in the Babylonian creation epic, Enuma Elish which story can be found in Old Testament Parallels by Victor H. Matthews and Don C. Benjamin page 17 " Having remodeled his temple with the spoils of war, Marduk then uses Tiamat's body to build a new world. He crushes her skull with his war club and scatters her blood into the wind. He splits her body in two. He uses half to make the heavens and half to make the earth. The body of Tiamat seals out the primeval waters at the mountains at the horizons. Marduk assigns the members of the divine assembly as constellations

to mark each season of the year. He assigns to guard the night and to mark the month with its phases. Finally, Marduk and Ea a plan to create humans."

Although I acknowledge this story to be myth but it agrees with the Bible at one point that there is something sealing up the waters above from those below.

The Jewish Study Bible on Genesis 1:6-8 {"6-8: The word translated *firmament* refers to a piece of metal that has been hammered flat. Here, the function of the sky is to separate the waters above (which fall as rain) from the subterranean waters "}

Origen who was alive from 185 to 254 AD states in his Homilies on Genesis 1:2 states {"Although God had already previously made heaven, now he makes the firmament. For he made the heavens first about which he states "Heaven is my throne" But after that he makes the firmament, that is the corporeal heaven. For every corporeal object is firm and solid; and it is this that divides the water which is above the heaven from the water which is below heaven"}

(Genesis 1:14-20) And God said, "Let there be lights in the dome of the sky to separate the day from the night; and let them be for signs and for seasons and for days and years, and let them be lights in the dome of the sky to give light upon the earth." And it was so. God made the two great lights--the greater light to rule the day and the lesser light to rule the night--and the stars. God set them in the dome of the sky to give light upon the earth, to rule over the day and over the night, and to separate the light from the darkness. And God saw that it was good. And there was evening and there was morning, the fourth day. And God said, "Let the waters bring forth swarms of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the dome of the sky." (NRSV)

The Book of Job states that this Dome is as a molten mirror

(Job 37:18) Can you, like him, spread out the skies, hard as a molten mirror? (NRSV)

Nasa states they have gone to the moon but yet they have not been able to repeat it for over 50 years. Why is that because they can not pass through the dome, arch, expanse, firmament or whatever you wish to call it.

I want to include some studies found in The Theological Wordbook of the Old Testament which states on the firmament and expansion because believers in Flat earth are constantly being mocked by fellow Christians who are telling them that what we believe is not found in the Hebrew or in the Scripture but it is. Flat earthers study their Bibles and believe it to the core that is why they are willing to be persecuted and mocked for their beliefs.

The Theological Wordbook of the Old Testament states {" 2217.0 רָקַע (*raqa'*) **stamp, spread out, stretch.**

Derivatives

(2217a) רָקִיעַ (*raqîa'*) **firmament.**

(2217b) רִיקּוּא (*riqqûa'*) **expansion.**

The **{Nu 17:3}** basic concept in *raqa* ‘ is stamping, as with the foot, and what results, i.e. a spreading out or stretching forth. In the OT the foot-stamping connotation of *raqa* ‘ may be understood literally, indicating either a malicious glee **{Eze 25:6}** or a threatening excitement. **{Eze 6:11}** } It may be used figuratively to describe beaten and crushed enemies. **{2Sa 22:43}** } In the Piel and Pual stems, the verb *raqa* ‘ acquires the sense of beating out precious metals, and of the spreading that results, e.g. to spread over (ASV, ‘overlay’) an image. **{Isa 40:19}** } For the gold of **Ex 39:3** *riqqa* ‘, ‘hammer out’ (RSV), is rendered ‘beat thin’; for the silver in **Jer 10:9**, ‘spread into plates’; and for the bronze in **Nu 16:39** [H 17.4], ‘make broad’ (plates). *raqa* ‘ then comes to denote God’s spreading forth the tangible earth, **{Isa 42:5 Isa 44:24}** } stretching out its land above the water, **{Ps 136:6}** } or spreading out the intangible sky. **{Job 37:18}** }

raqia ‘. Firmament. NASB renders more correctly as ‘expanse’; cf. *riqqu ‘ê pahîm* (**Nu 16:38** [H 17.3]), literally ‘an expansion of plates,’ i.e. broad plates, beaten out (BDB, p. 956). *raqia* ‘ may refer to a limited space, such as that of the canopy over the cherubim, under the throne in Ezekiel’s vision. **{Eze 1:22,26}** } Or it may refer to the broad ‘expanse of heaven’, **{Da 12:3, NASB}** } as it does in thirteen of its seventeen occurrences.

raqia ‘ is the most important derivative of *raqa* ‘. It identifies God’s heavenly expanse. The Mosaic account of creation uses *raqia* ‘ interchangeably for the ‘open expanse of the heavens’ in which birds fly, **{Ge 1:20 NASB}** } i.e. the atmosphere (H. C. Leupold, Exposition of Genesis, 1, p. 59), and that farther expanse of sky in which God placed ‘the lights ... for signs and for seasons’ (vv. 14,17, referring apparently to their becoming visible through the cloud cover; the stars, sun, and moon presumably having been created already in v. 3), i.e. empty space (ISBE, I, p. 315), over which, as Job said, ‘He stretches out the north’. **{Job 26:7}** } The former receives greater emphasis, particularly during that period before the second day, when the earth cooled sufficiently (?) to permit surface waters, separated from what must still have been a massive cloud-bank above, by the atmospheric expanse. **{Ge 1:6-8}** } Such circumstances serve to explain the OT’S poetic references to ‘doors’ or ‘windows’ for the phenomenon of rainfall, e.g., ‘He commanded the clouds above, and opened the doors of heaven’. **{Ps 78:23}** } That the Hebrews knew rain came from clouds is clear from **Isa 5:6**, etc.

In pre-Christian Egypt confusion was introduced into biblical cosmology when the LXX, perhaps under the influence of Alexandrian theories of a ‘stone vault’ of heaven, rendered *raqia* ‘ by *stereoma*, suggesting some firm, solid structure. This Greek concept was then reflected by the Latin *firmamentum*, hence KJV ‘firmament.’ To this day negative criticism speaks of the ‘vault, or ‘firmament,’ regarded by Hebrews as solid, and supporting ‘waters’ above it’ (BDB, p. 956); cf. the rendering of **Job 37:18**, ‘The skies, strong (*hazaqîm*) as a molten mirror, **{cf Ps 150:1, their ‘mighty expanse’}** } changed by the RSV to read, ‘the skies, hard.’ Babylonian mythology recounts how Marduk used half of Tiamat’s carcass to form the heavens (*shamamu*) held in place by a crossbar (!). In the OT, however, Isaiah insists that God ‘stretches out the heavens [lit.] like gauze; **{doq, Isa 40:22}** } and even Ezekiel’s limited canopy (*raqia* ‘) is ‘as the [lit.] eye of awesome ice’, **{Eze 1:22}** } i.e. transparent, ‘shining like crystal’ (RSV), though so dazzling as to be terrifying (KD; cf. **Da 12:3** ‘brightness’).

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Chapter 02: Four corners of the Earth

The Bible speaks about the four corners of the earth, to have four corners is to be flat. Should that be taken to be symbolic language or true fact. Let's look at the verses.

(Isaiah 11:12) He will set up a banner for the nations, And will assemble the outcasts of Israel, And gather together the dispersed of Judah From **the four corners of the earth**. (NKJV)

(Revelation 7:1) After these things I saw four angels standing at **the four corners of the earth**, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, on the sea, or on any tree. (NKJV)

(Revelation 20:8) and will go out to deceive the nations which are in **the four corners of the earth**, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle, whose number is as the sand of the sea. (NKJV)

Should the four corners of the earth be taken to mean just the four corners of the land like we see in Ezekiel?

(Ezekiel 7:2) "And you, son of man, thus says the Lord GOD to the land of Israel: 'An end! The end has come upon the four corners of the land. (NKJV)

I think maybe not. Four corners of the earth means just that. Four corners of the earth and to add to it would be adding to the scripture. A globe can not have four corners but a flat earth can.

Chapter 03 : The Earth does not move

The Bible teaches that the earth doesn't move. And according to modern Science the earth is spinning and going around the Sun. Which to me is kind of impossible for men to make it to space going up while the earth spins with out crashing. Or just think can a spinning ball hold water?

(1 Chronicles 16:30) Tremble before Him, all the earth. **The world also is firmly established, It**

shall not be moved. (NKJV)

(Psalms 93:1) The LORD reigns, He is clothed with majesty; The LORD is clothed, He has girded Himself with strength. Surely the world is established, so that it cannot be moved. (NKJV)

(Psalms 96:10) Say among the nations, "The LORD reigns; The world also is firmly established, It shall not be moved; He shall judge the peoples righteously." (NKJV)

(Isaiah 45:18) For thus says the LORD, Who created the heavens, Who is God, Who formed the earth and made it, Who has established it, Who did not create it in vain, Who formed it to be inhabited: "I am the LORD, and there is no other. (NKJV)

Someone may argue but there are other verses which states the earth is moving. Yes but it is more like a dare. I dare the earth to try to move when I firmly established it not to or it could be moving in the sense like when a earthquake hits, or having a people to be in fear , the land moves . An Example below.

(Psalms 99:1) The LORD reigns; Let the peoples tremble! He dwells between the cherubim; Let the earth be moved! (NKJV)

(Psalms 60:2) You have made the earth tremble; You have broken it; Heal its breaches, for it is shaking. (NKJV)

(Isaiah 14:16) "Those who see you will gaze at you, And consider you, saying: 'Is this the man who made the earth tremble, Who shook kingdoms, (NKJV)

Chapter 04 : The Earth has an End

If the world was round it would be hard to say the ends of the earth. For roundness has no ending points . If something is round it can't end but yet we read the ends of the earth. Only something flat can be said of having an ending. 34 times the scriptures states The earth has an end.

(Deuteronomy 33:17) His glory is like a firstborn bull, And his horns like the horns of the wild ox; Together with them He shall push the peoples To the ends of the earth; They are the ten thousands of Ephraim, And they are the thousands of Manasseh." (NKJV)

(1 Samuel 2:10) The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken in pieces; From heaven He will thunder against them. The LORD will judge the ends of the earth. "He will give strength to His king, And exalt the horn of His anointed." (NKJV)

Job 28:24 For He looks to the ends of the earth, And sees under the whole heavens,

Job 37:3 He sends it forth under the whole heaven, His lightning to the ends of the earth.

Job 38:13 That it might take hold of **the ends of the earth**, And the wicked be shaken out of it?

(Psalms 2:8) Ask of Me, and I will give You The nations for Your inheritance, And **the ends of the earth** for Your possession. (NKJV)

(Psalms 48:10) According to Your name, O God, So is Your praise to **the ends of the earth**; Your right hand is full of righteousness. (NKJV)

(Psalms 59:13) Consume them in wrath, consume them, That they may not be; And let them know that God rules in Jacob To **the ends of the earth**. Selah (NKJV)

(Psalms 65:5) By awesome deeds in righteousness You will answer us, O God of our salvation, You who are the confidence of all **the ends of the earth**, And of the far-off seas; (NKJV)

(Psalms 67:7) God shall bless us, And all **the ends of the earth** shall fear Him. (NKJV)

(Psalms 72:8) He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, And from the River to **the ends of the earth**. (NKJV)

(Psalms 98:3) He has remembered His mercy and His faithfulness to the house of Israel; All **the ends of the earth** have seen the salvation of our God. (NKJV)

(Psalms 135:7) He causes the vapors to ascend from **the ends of the earth**; He makes lightning for the rain; He brings the wind out of His treasures. (NKJV)

(Proverbs 17:24) Wisdom is in the sight of him who has understanding, But the eyes of a fool are on **the ends of the earth**. (NKJV)

(Proverbs 30:4) Who has ascended into heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all **the ends of the earth**? What is His name, and what is His Son's name, If you know? (NKJV)

(Isaiah 24:16) From **the ends of the earth** we have heard songs: "Glory to the righteous!" But I said, "I am ruined, ruined! Woe to me! The treacherous dealers have dealt treacherously, Indeed, the treacherous dealers have dealt very treacherously." (NKJV)

(Isaiah 40:28) Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, The Creator of **the ends of the earth**, Neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable. (NKJV)

(Isaiah 41:5) The coastlands saw it and feared, **The ends of the earth** were afraid; They drew near and came. (NKJV)

(Isaiah 41:9) You whom I have taken from **the ends of the earth**, And called from its farthest regions, And said to you, 'You are My servant, I have chosen you and have not cast you away: (NKJV)

(Isaiah 42:10) Sing to the LORD a new song, And His praise from **the ends of the earth**, You who go down to the sea, and all that is in it, You coastlands and you inhabitants of them! (NKJV)

(Isaiah 43:6) I will say to the north, 'Give them up!' And to the south, 'Do not keep them back!' Bring My

sons from afar, And My daughters from **the ends of the earth**- (NKJV)

(Isaiah 45:22) "Look to Me, and be saved, All you **ends of the earth**! For I am God, and there is no other. (NKJV)

(Isaiah 49:6) Indeed He says, 'It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob, And to restore the preserved ones of Israel; I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles, That You should be My salvation to **the ends of the earth**.'" (NKJV)

(Isaiah 52:10) The LORD has made bare His holy arm In the eyes of all the nations; And all **the ends of the earth** shall see The salvation of our God. (NKJV)

(Jeremiah 10:13) When He utters His voice, There is a multitude of waters in the heavens: "And He causes the vapors to ascend from **the ends of the earth**. He makes lightning for the rain, He brings the wind out of His treasures." (NKJV)

(Jeremiah 16:19) O LORD, my strength and my fortress, My refuge in the day of affliction, The Gentiles shall come to You From **the ends of the earth** and say, "Surely our fathers have inherited lies, Worthlessness and unprofitable things." (NKJV)

(Jeremiah 31:8) Behold, I will bring them from the north country, And gather them from **the ends of the earth**, Among them the blind and the lame, The woman with child And the one who labors with child, together; A great throng shall return there. (NKJV)

(Jeremiah 50:41) "Behold, a people shall come from the north, And a great nation and many kings Shall be raised up from **the ends of the earth**. (NKJV)

(Jeremiah 51:16) When He utters His voice-There is a multitude of waters in the heavens: "He causes the vapors to ascend from **the ends of the earth**; He makes lightnings for the rain; He brings the wind out of His treasures." (NKJV)

(Micah 5:4) And He shall stand and feed His flock In the strength of the LORD, In the majesty of the name of the LORD His God; And they shall abide, For now He shall be great To **the ends of the earth**; (NKJV)

(Zechariah 9:10) I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim And the horse from Jerusalem; The battle bow shall be cut off. He shall speak peace to the nations; His dominion shall be 'from sea to sea, And from the River to **the ends of the earth**.' (NKJV)

(Matthew 12:42) "The queen of the South will rise up in the judgment with this generation and condemn it, for she came from **the ends of the earth** to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and indeed a greater than Solomon is here. (NKJV)

(Luke 11:31) "The queen of the South will rise up in the judgment with the men of this generation and condemn them, for she came from **the ends of the earth** to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and indeed a greater than Solomon is here. (NKJV)

(Acts 13:47) "For so the Lord has commanded us: 'I have set you as a light to the Gentiles, That you

should be for salvation to **the ends of the earth.**" (NKJV)

Chapter 05: The Earth has Pillars

The earth is described in the Bible as having Pillars, although, Pillars imply flatness. One Pillar would be enough to hold a round earth but pillars implies a flat earth in large size.

(1 Samuel 2:8) He raises the poor from the dust And lifts the beggar from the ash heap, To set them among princes And make them inherit the throne of glory. "For **the pillars of the earth** are the LORD'S, And He has set the world upon them. (NKJV)

Also Heaven seems to have Pillars.

(Job 26:11) **The pillars of heaven** tremble, And are astonished at His rebuke. (NKJV)

In the book of Enoch the Pillars refers to the air or wind as the very pillars of Heaven and Earth.

Book of Enoch chapter 18 states {"I saw the treasures of all the winds: I saw how He had furnished with them the whole creation and the firm foundations of the earth. And I saw the corner-stone of the earth: I saw the four winds which bear [the earth and] the firmament of the heaven. And I saw how the winds stretch out the vaults of heaven, and have their station between heaven and earth: these are the pillars of the heaven. I saw the winds of heaven which turn and bring the circumference of the sun and all the stars to their setting. I saw the winds on the earth carrying the clouds: I saw the paths of the angels."}

Chapter 06: God drew a circle and not formed a circle on the abyss

The bottomless pit also called abyss which location is space we know this because the smoke of it darkens sun.

(Revelation 9:2) And he opened the bottomless pit, and smoke arose out of the pit like the smoke of a great furnace. So the sun and the air were darkened because of the smoke of the pit. (NKJV)

The deep also means the abyss, this is why The Reina-Valera (Spanish) 1865 states abismo

(Proverbios 8:27) Cuando componía los cielos, allí estaba yo; cuando señalaba por compás las sobreaz del abismo: (SRV18)

In the abyss God draws a circle , not molds a circle which implies flatness

(Proverbs 8:27) When He prepared the heavens, I was there, When He drew a circle on the face of the deep, (NKJV)

Chapter 07: The compass of the Earth

I used to think Isaiah 40:22 to mean God sits on the circle of the earth but the Hebrew word

pronounce chuwg could mean compass or disk as כחג much as it could mean circle and some translations translate it as compass or disk . A Compass or disk is flat.

(Isaiah 40:22 ISV) He's the one who sits above **the disk of the earth**, and its inhabitants are like grasshoppers. He's the one who stretches out the heavens like a curtain, and spreads them like a tent to live in,

John Wycliff in 1395 translated it compass from the latin

(Isaiah 40:22 Wycliff) Which sittith on **the cumpas of erthe**, and the dwelleris therofben as locustis; which stretchith forth heuenes as nouyt, and spredith abroad tho as a tabernacle to dwelle.

Chapter 08: The Heavens are not stretched around the Earth

No where does the Bible states that the heavens are stretched out around the earth but we do read they are stretched out which implies a flat earth and not a round one.

(Job 9:8) He alone **spreads out the heavens**, And treads on the waves of the sea; (NKJV)

(Psalms 104:2) Who cover Yourself with light as with a garment, **Who stretch out the heavens** like a curtain. (NKJV)

(Isaiah 40:22) It is He who sits above the circle of the earth, And its inhabitants are like grasshoppers, **Who stretches out the heavens** like a curtain, And spreads them out like a tent to dwell in. (NKJV)

(Isaiah 42:5) Thus says God the LORD, Who **created the heavens and stretched them out**, Who spread forth the earth and that which comes from it, Who gives breath to the people on it, And spirit to those who walk on it: (NKJV)

(Jeremiah 10:12) He has made the earth by His power, He has established the world by His wisdom, **And has stretched out the heavens** at His discretion. (NKJV)

(Jeremiah 51:15) He has made the earth by His power; He has established the world by His wisdom, **And stretched out the heaven** by His understanding. (NKJV)

This is why we see the heaven rolling away before the coming of Christ

(Revelation 6:14) Then **the sky receded as a scroll when it is rolled up**, and every mountain and island was moved out of its place. (NKJV)

(Isaiah 34:4) All the host of heaven shall be dissolved, And **the heavens shall be rolled up like a scroll**; All their host shall fall down As the leaf falls from the vine, And as fruit falling from a fig tree. (NKJV)

Which will be spoken more later on ,how when heavens are rolled away and Jesus comes he can be seen everywhere which only works on a flat earth and not a globe.

Chapter 09: The Earth is stretched out

For the Earth itself to be stretched out implies flatness not a globe like structure. And the Bible is clear on it being stretched out like we saw concerning the heavens . If it is stretched out it can't be a globe or round but flat.

(Psalms 136:6) To him that stretched out the earth above the waters, for his loving-kindness endureth for ever; (DBY)

(Psalms 136:6) To Him who stretched out the earth above the waters; for His mercy endures forever. (MKJV)

Chapter 10 : The Earth has a Foundation

If the Earth has a foundation it should not be round but flat. And the Bible is very clear of the world having a foundation.

(Job 38:4-6) "Where were you when I laid the foundations of the earth? Tell Me, if you have understanding. Who determined its measurements? Surely you know! Or who stretched the line upon it? To what were its foundations fastened? Or who laid its cornerstone, (NKJV)

(Psalms 104:5) You who laid the foundations of the earth, So that it should not be moved forever, (NKJV)

(Proverbs 8:29) When He assigned to the sea its limit, So that the waters would not transgress His command, When He marked out the foundations of the earth, (NKJV)

Chapter 11 : The Sun & Moon circuit above the Earth

The Sun is described as circuiting which means traveling from one end of heaven to the other.

(Psalms 19:1-6) <<To the Chief Musician. A Psalm of David.>> The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork. Day unto day utters speech, And night unto night reveals knowledge. There is no speech nor language Where their voice is not heard. Their line has gone out through all the earth, And their words to the end of the world. In them He has set a tabernacle for the sun, Which is like a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, And rejoices like a strong man to run its race. Its rising is from one end of heaven, And its circuit to the other end; And there is nothing hidden from its heat. (NKJV)

(Ecclesiastes 1:5) The sun also rises, and the sun goes down, And hastens to the place where it arose. (NKJV)

Chapter 12 : Nebuchadnezzar's Vision

Nebuchadnezzar's Vision of a tall tree that could be seen through all the earth shows evidence of a flat earth for if the world was round it would not be possible to be seen by everyone.

(Daniel 4:10-11) "These were the visions of my head while on my bed: "I was looking, and behold, **A tree in the midst of the earth, And its height was great. The tree grew and became strong; Its height reached to the heavens, And it could be seen to the ends of all the earth.** (NKJV)

NRSV states in the center of the Earth stating Earth has a center was the tree which could be seen. Only a flat earth could have a center and not a round earth.

(Daniel 4:10-11) Upon my bed this is what I saw; **there was a tree at the center of the earth, and its height was great. The tree grew great and strong, its top reached to heaven, and it was visible to the ends of the whole earth.** (NRSV)

But then again this was a vision to show the king of what God was going to do with him and not to show the flatness of the earth but yet one can argue on this point as well that the vision doesn't show a round Earth but a flat earth.

Chapter 13: Being able to see all the kingdoms from a high Mountain

Jesus saw all the kingdoms of the earth from a really high mountain the devil took him to. Although Jesus is God and could see all the kingdoms of the earth from anywhere. In his humanity how could he see all the kingdoms of the earth from the mountain if it was round. Only way to see that is through a mountain on a flat earth.

(Matthew 4:8) Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor; (NRSV)

(Luke 4:5) Then the devil led him up and showed him in an instant all the kingdoms of the world. (NRSV)

Chapter 14: Every eye will See Christ in his second coming

When Christ comes again the Bible makes it very clear that everyone will see him. Just like everyone will see the rolling away of the sky. See Chapter 8 for reference on the rolling away of the sky like a scroll. How is that possible with a globe earth. For if the earth was a globe one side of the earth would see him but the other part will not. Because if the earth was a globe it would be impossible but if the earth was flat this is very much possible.

(Revelation 1:7) Behold, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him, even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him. Even so, Amen. (NKJV)

(Matthew 24:30) "Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. (NKJV)

Chapter 15: Peter's description of the earth

The Apostle Peter describes the earth as under water and overwater. The earth is right in the middle of two waters.

(2 Peter 3:5-6) For this they willfully forget: that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of water and in the water, by which the world that then existed perished, being flooded with water. (NKJV)

Peter quotes Genesis 1 where we see the waters being divided into two one above and one below. See chapter 1 when it speaks of the Dome for more info.

(Genesis 1:6-9) Then God said, "Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters." Thus God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament; and it was so. And God called the firmament Heaven. So the evening and the morning were the second day. Then God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear"; and it was so. (NKJV)

Waters in the sky can be seen also in the Psalms

(Psalms 104:3) He lays the beams of His upper chambers in the waters, Who makes the clouds His chariot, Who walks on the wings of the wind, (NKJV)

(Psalms 148:4) Praise Him, you heavens of heavens, And you waters above the heavens! (NKJV)

Chapter 16: Sun, Moon and stars can only stand still if the earth is flat

Joshua spoke to God so the Moon with the Sun could stand still and it did . This would be impossible on a globe earth which spins and goes around the Sun. But not so if the Sun and moon is not as big as we been lied to by NASA. And if the Sun and moon circuit as seen in chapter 11 on the dome of the sky. Which can only be done on a flat earth.

(Joshua 10:12-14) Then Joshua spoke to the LORD in the day when the LORD delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel: "Sun, stand still over Gibeon; And Moon, in the Valley of Aijalon." So the sun stood still, And the moon stopped, Till the people had revenge Upon their enemies. Is this not written in the Book of Jasher? So the sun stood still in the midst of heaven, and did not hasten to go down for about a whole day. And there has been no day like that, before it or after it, that the LORD heeded the voice of a man; for the LORD fought for Israel. (NKJV)

A reference to the event in Joshua is found in Habakkuk

(Habakkuk 3:11-12) The sun and moon stood still in their habitation; At the light of Your arrows they went, At the shining of Your glittering spear. You marched through the land in indignation; You trampled the nations in anger. (NKJV)

We also see of a Star leading the wise men to the house Jesus was in and standing still at the location.

(Matthew 2:1-10) Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, saying, "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him." When Herod the king heard this, he was troubled, and all Jerusalem with him. And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. So they said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it is written by the prophet: 'But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, Are not the least among the rulers of Judah; For out of you shall come a Ruler Who will shepherd My people Israel.'" Then Herod, when he had secretly called the wise men, determined from them what time the star appeared. And he sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search carefully for the young Child, and when you have found Him, bring back word to me, that I may come and worship Him also." When they heard the king, they departed; and behold, the star which they had seen in the East went before them, till it came and stood over where the young Child was. When they saw the star, they rejoiced with exceedingly great joy. (NKJV)

Chapter 17: Stars falling to the Earth

While the term Stars can refer to angels in the Bible.

(Revelation 1:20) "The mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands which you saw are the seven churches. (NKJV)

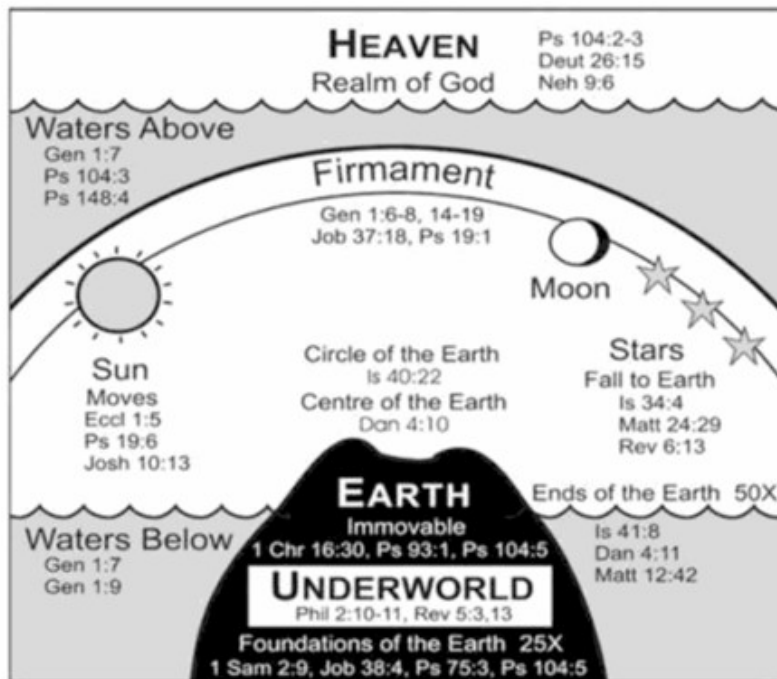
(Revelation 8:10) Then the third angel sounded: And a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water. (NKJV)

It is unlikely that is the case in Isaiah , Matthew and not all of Revelation

(Isaiah 34:4) All the host of heaven shall be dissolved, And the heavens shall be rolled up like a scroll; All their host shall fall down As the leaf falls from the vine, And as fruit falling from a fig tree. (NKJV)

(Matthew 24:29) "Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. (NKJV)

(Revelation 6:13) And the stars of heaven fell to the earth, as a fig tree drops its late figs when it is shaken by a mighty wind. (NKJV)



Chapter 18 The Book of Enoch supports the View of a Flat earth

The book of Enoch is a book that is often quoted in our New Testament and it supports the view of a flat earth. We could see it refer to in James, 2 Peter and in Jude.

James 2:1 My brothers, have no favoritism of persons (respect of persons, partialities) in the faith (belief, trust) of our Lord (Master) Jesus the Anointed (Christ, Messiah), the Lord of glory (our Lord Jesus Christ of glory).

James in the ending of the verse will set Jesus as the Lord of glory mention in 1 Enoch Chapter 22 {"Then I blessed the Lord of glory and said: 'Blessed be my Lord, the Lord of righteousness, who ruleth for ever.'"}.

2 Peter 2:4 For if God did not show mercy to (spare) the angels who sinned, but cast them down to Tartarus (hell) and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment;

Peter here refers to 1 Enoch 10:11-17 which states {"All the sons of men shall not perish in consequence of every secret, by which the Watchers have destroyed, and which they have taught, their offspring. All the earth has been corrupted by the effects of the teaching of Azazyel. To him therefore ascribe the whole crime. To Gabriel also the Lord said, Go to the biters, to the reprobates, to the children of fornication; and destroy the children of fornication, the offspring of the Watchers, from among men; bring them forth, and excite them one against another. Let them perish by mutual slaughter; for length of days shall not be theirs. They shall all entreat you, but

their fathers shall not obtain their wishes respecting them; for they shall hope for eternal life, and that they may live, each of them, five hundred years. To Michael likewise the Lord said, Go and announce his crime to Samyaza, and to the others who are with him, who have been associated with women, that they might be polluted with all their impurity. And when all their sons shall be slain, when they shall see the perdition of their beloved, bind them for seventy generations underneath the earth, even to the day of judgment, and of consummation, until the judgment, the effect of which will last for ever, be completed. Then shall they be taken away into the lowest depths of the fire in torments; and in confinement shall they be shut up for ever. Immediately after this shall he, together with them, burn and perish; they shall be bound until the consummation of many generations. "}

Jude 14 And Enoch also, the 7th generation from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold (Lo, see) ,the Master comes with myriads (innumerable , ten thousands) of his saints (holy ones) .

This is a quotation of Book of Enoch chapter 1:9{" And behold! He cometh with ten thousands of his holy ones To execute judgment upon all, And destroy all the ungodly: And to convict all flesh of all the works of their ungodliness which they have ungodly committed, And of all the hard things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."} And chapter 60 has the same meaning but the words are changed {" And when the day, and the power, and the punishment, and the judgment come, which the Lord of the Spirits hath prepared for those who worship not the righteous law, and for those who deny the righteous judgement, and for those who take his name in vain-that day is prepared for the elect a covenant, but for sinners an inquisition. When the punishment of Lord of Spirits may not come, in vain, and it shall slay the children with their mothers and the children with their fathers. Afterward the judgment shall take place according to his mercy and patience"}

For examples of how this Book of Enoch speaks of a flat earth it states :

Earth has a End

Book of Enoch Chapter 34 {"And from thence I went towards the north to the ends of the earth, and there I saw a great and glorious device at the ends of the whole earth."}

Book of Enoch Chapter 36 {" And from thence I went to the south to the ends of the earth, and saw there three open portals of the heaven: and thence there come dew, rain, and wind...."}

It mentions the vault and the pillars

Book of Enoch Chapter 18 {"I saw the treasures of all the winds: I saw how He had furnished with them the whole creation and the firm foundations of the earth. And I saw the corner-stone of the earth: I saw the four winds which bear [the earth and] the firmament of the heaven. And I saw how the winds stretch out the vaults of heaven, and have their station between heaven and earth: these are the pillars of the heaven. "}

Chapter 19 : Myths that some people teach about Flat Earthers

A) There are certain people who mocking flat earthers say that we believe that we could fall off the earth if we sail long enough . Flat Earthers do not teach one can fall off the earth. 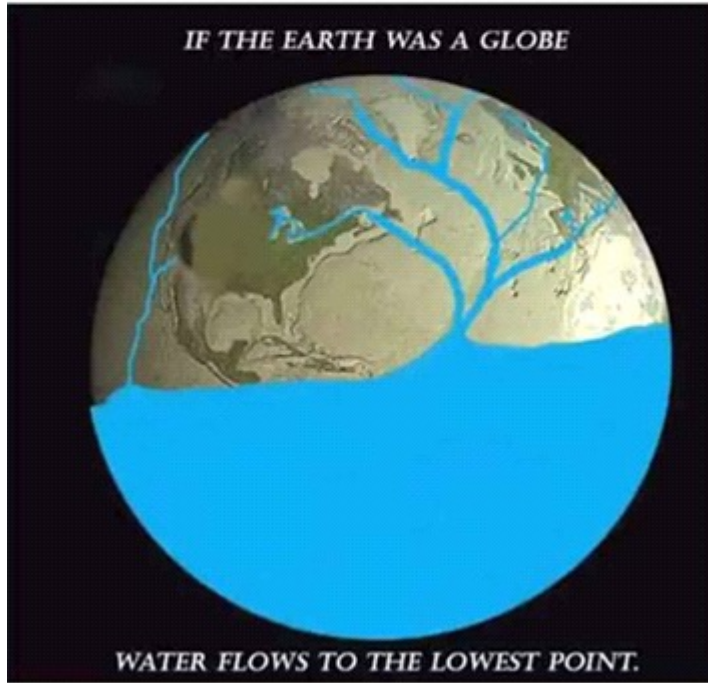

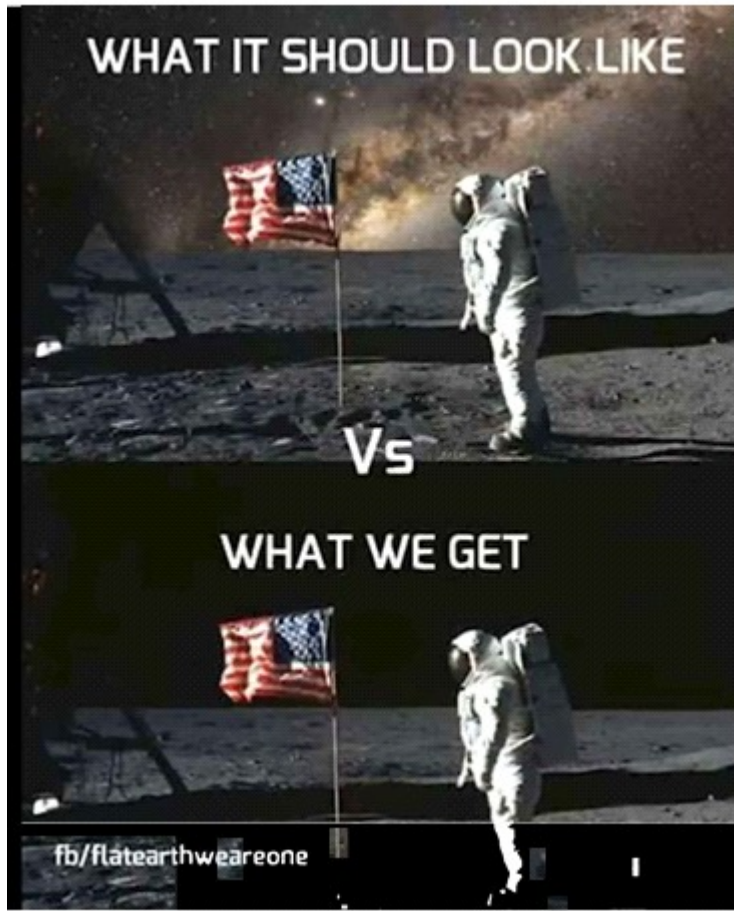
